

Shoo the flu! Report your influenza immunization status.

Dear Faculty or Student,

Park Nicollet requires all students report their flu immunization status. This means you must report the date you were vaccinated or reason you are declining the flu immunization. **Reporting is now mandatory through one of the two following Options.**

Option 1. Faculty completes flu status listing for all nursing students who will be on campus

Faculty can use this Survey Monkey link to capture flu immunization status of groups of nursing students that will be on the Park Nicollet Methodist Hospital campus.

Option 2. Student completes an individual survey monkey reporting their flu status

Students can use this Survey Monkey link to report his/her individual flu declination or immunization.

No computer access? Students can verbally report his/her flu immunization decision by stopping by EOHS in Meadowbrook W515 or call 952-993-5080, option 2. Give your name, date of birth, date and place you were vaccinated **or** reason you wish to decline. Declination reasons include:

- a. I am severely allergic to eggs. *NOTE: EOHS can now order a dose of flu vaccine that is egg free. Email eohs@parknicollet.com or call 952-993-5080 to request*
- b. I am allergic to a component of the influenza vaccine.
- c. I have another medical reason for not receiving the influenza vaccine. _____
- d. My reason for declining is my personal choice.
