Position Purpose

The Student Nurse (SN) position provides an opportunity for pre-licensure students capable of providing entry-level professional nursing care to promote, attain, maintain, and restore the health of North Memorial Medical Center (NMMC) clients under the supervision of a registered nurse. The SN provides holistic, compassionate care to patients and families. The scope of practice may include the care of neonates, infants, children, young adults, adults, and older adults throughout the life cycle. The SN executes the Standards of Nursing Practice including: assessment; nursing diagnosis; outcome identification; planning; implementation; and evaluation.

Unit/Department Specific (if applicable)

Variation of duties may result based on the assigned patient care unit(s). This may include differences in the specific clinical skills required of the SN.

Accountabilities:

- Identifies and applies nursing concepts and principles to meet the needs of assigned patients and families.
- Applies nursing process in assisting assigned patients and families to meet health care needs
 including: collecting, validating, and analyzing data; implementing nursing interventions under the
 direction of a registered nurse; evaluates patients' response to nursing interventions.
- Collaborates with intra and interdisciplinary team members to provide continuity of patient care.
- Recognizes emergent and unsafe situations and reports promptly to clinical faculty and/or coassigned NMMC registered nurse.
- Safely carries out nursing interventions following appropriate preparation/learning.
- Provides information/teaching that is appropriate to the patients' and families level of understanding.
- Is accountable and responsible for own nursing practice including: systematic evaluation of quality, safety, and effectiveness of patient care practices; ; seeks and accepts appropriate guidance; promptly reports untoward events and errors to appropriate persons; maintains professional demeanor.
- Accepts other appropriate duties as assigned to promote the accomplishment of defined goals.

Compliance

- Recognizes and complies with legal regulatory, accrediting and procedural requirements related to area of responsibility.
- Understands and follows principles and standards as outlined in North Memorial's Corporate Code of Conduct
- Protects patient/employee privacy and only accesses patient/employee related information as needed to perform job duties.
